

2025 to Bring Stability for SA Budget Grocers, Gold Miners

With South Africa's operating environment projected to improve, analysts from Moody's Investors Services are expecting stability for various industries.

Lowering interest rates, receding inflationary pressures, reduced electricity load shedding and movements to fix the logistics sector, including ports and rail, have all provided a strong bedrock for firmer business confidence in South Africa.

Moody's analysts, however, said they believed that despite the improved electricity supply situation under Eskom in the past few months, energy availability remained a constraint for South African companies. The Minerals Council and other business groupings have recently voiced out against the high costs of electricity. "Energy availability, while improving, remains a constraint," said Moody's.


Nonetheless, the ratings agency sees South Africa's economy rebounding by 1.7% for 2025. "In South Africa, the operating environment is set to improve; we expect retailers focused on budget-conscious consumers to stabilise and grow above the inflation rate," said Moody's analysts.

approach, which involves reimagining the customer experience in the digital environment, can



Agri Trade Poised to Benefit from South Africa's Global Positioning In 2025

There is an opportunity for SA's agricultural industry to focus on BRICS countries, which only account for 8% of exports over the past ten years.

With the 2024/25 season expected to benefit from La Niña rains, solid exports having been reported in the year-to-date, food price inflation having come down to 2.8% in October and the Agribusiness Confidence Index having increased by ten points to 58 in the fourth quarter of the year, experts are optimistic that the agriculture sector will grow meaningfully in 2025.

During a media day hosted by the Agricultural Business Chamber of South Africa (Agbiz), CEO Theo Boshoff said the sector would benefit further from political stability effected by the Government of National Unity, progress with rail reforms, improved energy security and South Africa's positioning within BRICS and in leading the Group of 20 (G20) in 2025.

The threats to the sector, however, include rising protectionism globally, geopolitical instability that impacts on prices and supply chain activity and green trade barriers.
